

Springers Leisure Centre Information Sheet



Welcome to the 2012 Winter season. To enter a competition at Springers Leisure Centre, you will need to familiarise yourself with the enclosed information. This pack includes the rules & by-laws for each sport played at Springers Leisure Centre, a registration form, registration opening & closing dates and season dates on the timetable.

REGISTRATION POLICY

The following information will provide you with a brief description of the guidelines used for the registering of sporting teams at the commencement of a new season.

To ensure your registration is processed correctly, a checklist is provided on the front of your registration form. Please use this checklist prior to providing us with all the paperwork we require for your registration.

The following is a step-by-step procedure for registering into Springers Leisure Centre sports competitions.

Step 1. By- Laws

Read the competition information for your particular sport.

Step 2. Registration dates

Read the registration dates on the registration form. The registration dates differ for pre-existing teams and new teams.

Existing Teams

In the lead up to the end of a season (and just prior to the start of a new season) all existing teams will be notified of the registration dates and invited to re-register. Registrations submitted with all the relevant paperwork and registration fee by the designated registration date will be entered into the competition.

New Teams

New teams need to submit their completed paperwork accompanied with the appropriate registration fee as soon as possible (on or after the designated date) to give the team the best possible opportunity of being accepted.

Registering during the season

Persons enquiring during a season about entering a new team will have their details taken and recorded. If space permits, the team may be offered a place to start ASAP (part way through a season). If there is no space for the team to start immediately, the team will be placed on a waiting list. At this point in time, information can be provided about the starting dates for the next season.

IMPORTANT

Registrations will only be accepted from the dates provided on the timetable.

Step 3. Competition dates

Competition dates are located on the timetable. Please read through the dates carefully and ensure you note the weeks your games will not be scheduled to play. The game times scheduled for each evening are between 6.10pm and 11.00pm. A mix of game times will be scheduled for each team.

“Byes” maybe considered where deemed appropriate to enable more team registrations to be accepted. Some competitions / grades / divisions may fill up quicker than others.

Step 4. Registration form

Below are a few tips to filling out this form:

Ensure all team members have filled out their contact details on the registration sheet and completed the checklist, located on the back. If this section is not filled out, your registration sheet may not be processed.

All players including fill in must have their details recorded on the registration sheet, name, address, contact number and signature or the games played will not be counted towards eligibility for finals. Any games played prior to filling out the registration form will not be counted towards finals eligibility.

Springers Leisure Centre reserves the right to remove or ban players and/or teams from the competition for behavioural or financial misconduct.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What happens if a team member is unable to attend their scheduled game?

The team may nominate a substitute player. Please be advised that the substitute player must register at reception prior to the game.

What happens if you cancel a game?

ALL CANCELLED GAMES ARE SUBJECT TO A WALK OVER FEE.

Please refer to individual game information sheets.

What happens if you don't have uniforms ready for the start of the competition?

Springers Leisure Centre has uniforms for hire. Netball bibs are \$3 and basketball singlets are \$5 a set.

Is a team able to register new players throughout the season?

Yes, please see our friendly staff at reception that will supply you with the teams registration form for you to complete.

Is there an age requirement for each sport?

Yes. Netball is 15yrs of age. Men's Basketball 16yrs of age.

Can I register without all the team members' information on the registration form?

Registrations will not be accepted unless all team members' information is provided. This information is critical to have on file so all players can be contacted for when we need to communicate with them.

What is the procedure for withdrawing out of the competition?

The Team Captain will need to contact the Senior Program Co-Ordinator during office hours and a \$70 withdrawal fee will need to be paid.

What do I do if I injure myself while playing?

Ask a team member to advise a Springers Leisure Centre staff member. A staff member will administer first aid if required. An incident report form must be completed at time of injury.

How does a team qualify for the finals?

Teams that finish 1-4 on a ladder will qualify for finals.

Teams in an A/B grade from 1-4/ 5-8 on the ladder will qualify for finals.

All players must be registered correctly to qualify for finals and must have played the required amount of games. Netball Players must play a minimum of 5 games to qualify for finals. Basketball Players must play a minimum of 6 games to qualify for finals.

Where can I check my game results?

Fixtures and ladders can be located on the Springers Leisure Centre website www.springerslc.com.au Please stay up to date with your online fixture, as it may change. It is recommended you check the website 48 hours before each game to make sure you have the correct details for your team.

It is the team's responsibility to ensure you're ready to play at the fixture time.
